## **Understanding Part B coverage and reimbursement**

- Medicare Part B covers drugs administered by infusion or injection in physician offices and hospital outpatient departments
- Drugs covered under Part B must be reasonable and necessary for the diagnosis or treatment of an illness or injury
- Coverage can depend on multiple factors, including patient diagnosis, type of drug, route of administration, and administration setting
- In the absence of a product's average selling price at launch, Medicare reimbursement for products under Part B is wholesale acquisition cost + 3%
