## **Understanding Part-B coverage**and reimbursement

- Medicare Part-B covers drugs administered by infusion or injection in physician offices and hospital outpatient departments<sup>1</sup>
- Drugs covered under Part-B must be reasonable and necessary for the diagnosis or treatment of an illness or injury<sup>1</sup>
- Coverage can depend on multiple factors, including patient diagnosis, type of drug, route of administration, and administration setting<sup>1</sup>
- Per Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the allowable amount for reimbursement of products under Part-B is ASP + 6%<sup>1,2</sup>
